Moho reckons its Queensland deposit has shades of PNG's massive Hidden Valley resource

Moho Resources (ASX:MOH) has told investors that its Empress Spring gold mineralisation bears an uncanny resemblance to Keilan in Indonesia and Hidden Valley in PNG.

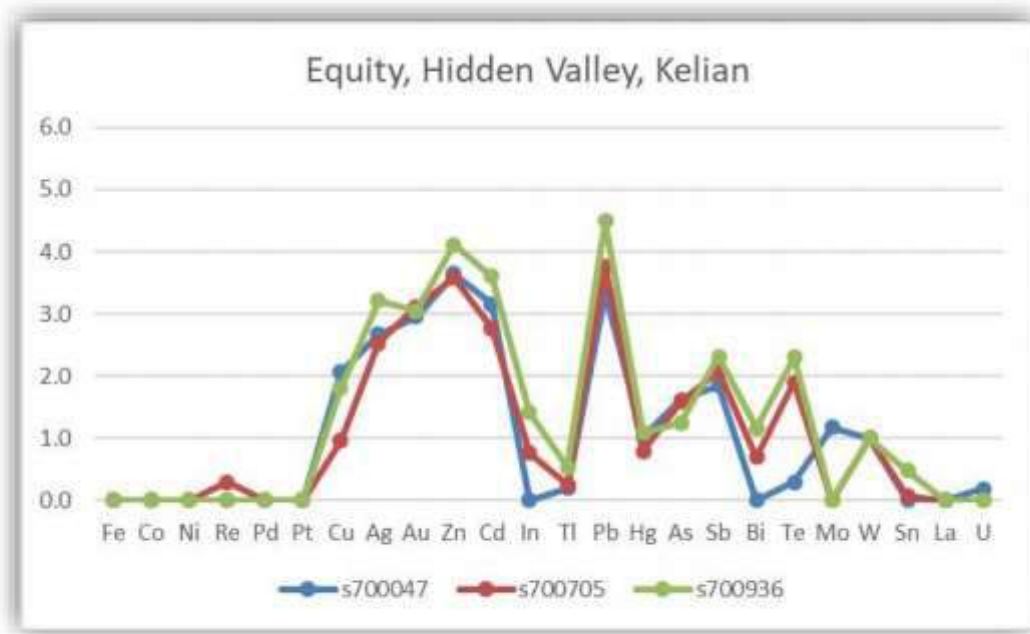
- New geochemical interpretation finds samples from Arrowhead prospect at Empress Spring bears resemblance to Keilan and Hidden Valley gold.
- Reverse circulation drilling underway at Arrowhead to provide more fodder for exploration program
- This will be followed up with 7000m aircore program to follow-up on lateral extensions at Arrowhead

New interpretation of drilling done last year has found Moho's Arrowhead prospect is an analogue of Keilan and Hidden valley.

While it's not a perfect match, the new analysis done by CSA Global and GCExplore gives Moho guidance

Valley contains a resource of 89Mt at 1.43 grams per tonne gold and 87Mt silver at 27g/t.

Richard Carver of GCExplore recommended the company follow-up with drilling to the north — which Moho is doing.

Moho’s flagship exploration project is Empress Springs, which is a gold project in Northern Queensland, about 25km south of Croydon — which was at one time the largest goldfield in Queensland.

Outcropping there (which makes up just 40 percent of the total province area) contained a non-JORC reserve of 2.84Mt @ 3.4g/t — with production of 1.2 million ounces of gold.

Moho is hoping modern exploration techniques can unlock the rest of the province as a gold powerhouse — but it’s also hoping the region could host base metals.

Moho’s Board is chaired by Terry Streeter, a well-known and highly successful West Australian businessman with extensive experience in funding and overseeing exploration and mining companies, including Jubilee Mines NL, Western Areas NL and Midas Resources Ltd.
